Jorge Leon and Judy Nunno have been accepted into Florida Watercolor Society's Golden Anniversary Annual Exhibition.

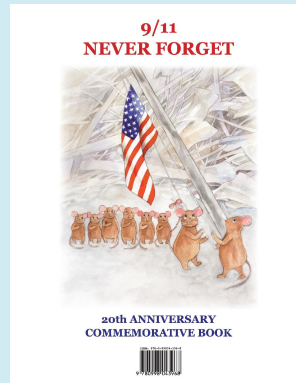
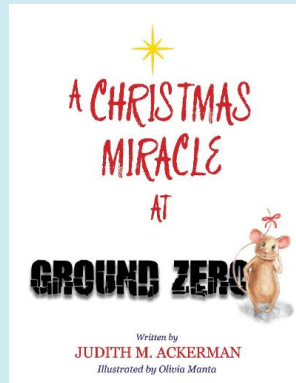
