Julia shared an interesting comment about the invention of the metal tube which helped expand opportunities for plein aire artists in the mid 1800's. The metal paint tube was invented in 1841 by portrait painter John Goffe

Rand, This simple invention helped to replace the paint sold in pig bladders and glass tubes making plein-aire painting easier for impressionists such as Claude Monet .
